What do greeters do?

High School Greeters volunteer on a designated performance day and time for each production in the **Taco and The White Family Foundation Broadway Series**.

Starting one hour prior to show time, they welcome and hand out program books to patrons. Greeters also volunteer during intermission and answer patrons' questions.

New and returning greeters must attend an orientation session in early September at PPAC. The program coordinator will contact you via email with an exact date and time.

What do greeters receive?

1. This program is eligible for community service hours; please inquire with the program coordinator in advance.
2. The chance to take responsibility and make a commitment to the Greeter Program while learning about the Broadway touring shows presented at PPAC.
3. The opportunity to enhance social skills while welcoming and assisting audience members in person.
4. The opportunity to watch most of these fantastic shows live on stage!
5. Option to renew participation in the program each season through age 18.
