- Download a customizable social narrative created for this event, at https://www.ppacri.org/outreach/sensory-friendly-performances and review prior to the performance.
- DOORS OPEN at 1:00 PM
 RUNNING TIME is approximately 70 minutes with no intermission.
- Small coping tools (i.e.: fidgets, weighted blankets, headphones etc.) are allowed in the theatre.
- To accommodate dietary restrictions, snacks from home are permitted.
