Re: COVID protocols

Like on BROADWAY, every member of the cast plays a critical role in supporting one another -- on stage and off.

With everyone's health and safety in mind, we are encouraging every member of the cast to take a COVID test each morning, regardless of vaccination status. For Monday morning, if you do not have one at home, please just arrive between 8:15 and 8:30 AM, and we'll have tests available. At the end of the day on Monday, we'll send 4 tests home with each cast member for the remainder of the week.

Masks will be welcome but not required, and we will have masks available, as well.

PPAC will continue to implement its cleaning protocols for the health and safety of patrons and guests. We will integrate regular opportunities for hand-washing and hand-sanitation throughout the program.

We ask all families to be in touch proactively if your cast member tests positive or is ill in the days leading up to the start of the program so we can work together to determine the best course of action.

If, prior to the start of the program, the Rhode Island Department of Health issues new guidelines or protocols, we will update our protocols and inform you accordingly.
