Tour Parking, Loading, Entering, and Exiting




Upon arriving at the back of the building, you will notice our two loading docks as well as our stage and Richmond St. entrances.

Main Entrance is as shown in photo to the right. FOH equipment and merchandise, may be brought into venue through these doors.

Richmond St. Entrance is used as extra storage for some equipment. It is also and egress for the general public.

Stage Door is marked as such; staff, crew, and talent will enter through this door. Upon entering PPAC technical director's office is located to your immediate left.



Main Loading Dock is shown in above photo. Main dock fits one trailer and cab at a time or up to three vehicles. Trailer may be backed up directly to door. Loading door, and stage are at ground level. During a show run, a trailer may stay on the dock with out its cab. Tour bus, tractor trailer, and cab parking will be discussed and designated via advancement with Technical Director.

Secondary Loading Door is shown in above photo. This door is situated at center stage and is at ground level. Loading door may not be directly backed up to. During a show run, trucks, trailers, buses, and cars may not be parked on Pine St. unless specifically discussed and designated via advancement with Technical Director.

Bus & Trailer Parking is designated on Pine St. on the PPAC side. This is to be discussed and designated via advancement with Technical Director as permits must be submitted prior to arrival.
