Tickets for **A GALA CELEBRATION STARRING JOSH GROBAN** will go on sale to the general public on Monday, September 20, 2021 at 10A at the PPAC Box Office (220 Weybosset Street in downtown Providence), online at [ppacri.org](http://ppacri.org), and by phone at 401.421.ARTS (2787). Tickets are \$175 - \$49; all ticket prices include a \$4 per ticket restoration charge and are subject to change without notice. Box Office phone and window hours are Monday through Friday, 10A to 5P.

PPAC does not have any capacity restrictions; all event staff are fully vaccinated. PPAC is a GBAC STAR® accredited performing arts venue, indicating that the theatre has adopted the most stringent protocols for cleaning, disinfection, and infectious disease prevention. Grammy, Tony, and Emmy Award-nominated singer, songwriter, and actor **JOSH GROBAN** has entertained fans across the globe with his multi-platinum albums (over 35 million sold worldwide) and electrifying live performances. He has appeared in multiple films and TV shows, and starred on Broadway in *Natasha, Pierre & The Great Comet of 1812*, which *Time Out New York* called, “one of the best musicals of the decade”. Over the past year, he released his latest album *Harmony*, a collection of timeless songs, and has performed a series of intimate concerts livestreamed to audiences all over the world.

Groban maintains his position as the consummate American showman in 2021 and beyond. He remains an active arts education philanthropist and advocate, and his *Find Your Light Foundation* helps enrich the lives of young people through arts, education, and cultural awareness.
