An excellent introduction for middle school students to the life and works of William Shakespeare, this literary concert will include multi-media presentations, a live band, and period costumes, providing information about Shakespeare’s life and influence on our culture.

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This performance will begin promptly at 9:40 AM and will last for approximately 1 hour. ***Students arriving later than 9:40 AM will have to be seated without the aid of house lights in the Theatre.*** Please note that it may take up to one additional hour for all students to be called for their bus at the conclusion of the performance. Precise departure times can’t be given as buses are not called in any particular order.

Approximately four weeks before the performance, a study guide will be sent to all registered teachers for use in the classroom. At the event, “report cards” will be given to teachers and students for feedback. Once the report cards have been completed, they should be mailed back to PPAC, attention Cynthia Goldsmith.

Admission to the **Bank of America Arts Showcase is free, but advance reservations are required.** Carefully complete the contract, make a copy for your files, and forward one copy to the Providence Performing Arts Center via fax or U.S. mail as soon as possible.
