- I will keep my microphone muted unless being worked with or spoken to directly.
- I will not chew gum during the master class.
- I will be focused throughout the master class, take notes and listen to the instructor's directions/feedback.
- I will respect my peers and instructor by listening and behaving appropriately.
- I will keep a positive attitude during the master class.
- I will respect the judgment of the instructor regarding my progress in the program.
- I will be respectful of different viewpoints, cultures and lifestyles.
